Enquiry A

When testing to Appendix VA of 15 NZS 61347.1, and so applying AS/NZS 60598.1 Clause 12.4.1 c), is such testing conducted of an ambient test temperature between 10 °C and 30 °C, referred to 25 °C. When testing to Appendix VA of ASAN, such testing conducted at an ambient disregarding the tablithe control gear?
